Then and Now – Isaiah 9

Since Isaiah's commissioning in chapter 6 we have seen the warning of judgement to come to those who do not trust in God. Israel – the northern kingdom – is under threat. Syria – to the north of Israel – is warned of what is coming. And Judah – the southern kingdom, and God's specific chosen people – are giving the choice to escape judgement by obeying God's word. However, while all this talk of judgement is going on we are introduced to a number of children. Isaiah's son, Shear-jashub, in 7:3. Immanuel in 7:14, 8:8 and 8:10. Isaiah's other son, Mahershalal-hash-baz, in 8:1 and 3. And this week a Davidic child king, 9:6 and 7. The message seems to be that God brings hope to humanity through new birth.
