# Don't Be Deceived! - 2 Thessalonians 2

In the second chapter of this second letter to the new church in Thessalonica, the Apostle Paul moves directly to the central purpose of his writing. In his first letter (1 Thess. 4:13-5:11), Paul had already addressed the return of Jesus, but it seems that some believers had been misled into thinking that Jesus had already come again. Paul therefore takes the time to clarify what the believers should expect as they wait for Jesus' return. In the end, rebellion and lawlessness will spread, and there one man will rise up and set himself up in opposition to God, even claiming to be God. The believers must not be deceived or swept up in the lies of this Antichrist figure but are to stand firm and hold fast to the teachings passed down by the apostles, knowing that when the Lord Jesus does return, He will overthrow this lawless one with the breath of his mouth and the splendour of His coming. As we continue to wait for Jesus' return, may we trust in his power to save, and remain watchful, steadfast, and not easily deceived.




#### **WELCOME TO THE BISHOP OF GRAFTON:**
